Reunited

8. The voice of my beloved! behold, he cometh leaping upon the mountains, skipping upon the hills.
9. My beloved is like a roe or a young hart: behold, he standeth behind our wall, he looketh forth at the windows, shewing himself through the lattice.

10. My beloved spake, and said unto me, Rise up, my love, my fair one, and come away.
11. For, lo, the winter is past, the rain is over and gone;

Threats to Her Fruitbearing

- * **Songs 2:1** - As the lily among thorns, so is my love among the daughters.
- * **Luke 8:14** - And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection.

Little Foxes

- * **Jude 1:4** - For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.
- * **Rom 6:1** - What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?

5. I charge you, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that ye stir not up, nor awake my love, till [she] please.

Beauty of Holiness

- * Chapter 4 details out the beauties of this woman that is newly rededicated to Him.
- * The beauty of her eyes, teeth, lips, speech, temples, neck, etc. are all covered.
- * In summary, in verse 7, He says, “Thou art all fair, my love; there is no spot in thee.”
- * In verses 8-11 He goes into greater detail about specific attributes that have “ravished [his] heart”

A Garden Inclosed

- * **Songs 4:12** - A garden inclosed is my sister, my spouse; a spring shut up, a fountain sealed.
- * **Songs 4:16** - Awake, O north wind; and come, thou south; blow upon my garden, that the spices thereof may flow out.

A Life Poured Out

- * **Proverbs 11:25** - The liberal soul shall be made fat: and he that watereth shall be watered also himself.
- * **I Peter 4:10,11** - As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Shut Out Again!

5. I rose up to open to my beloved; and my hands dropped with myrrh, and my fingers with sweet smelling myrrh, upon the handles of the lock.

Chastisement/Reproof

Confesses Him

- * She realizes the gospel is not just about her; He is the good news
- * This is a major turning point in her life; no more shutting Him out
- * She witnesses a good confession (1 Tim 6:13); HIM
